Personal Belonging Pick-Up

We have set up times when you can come and pick up your child's materials. (School library books may be dropped off with staff at this time also.)

Pick-up dates and times:

(First Letter of the last name)

- May 5: Last Names I-O 9 AM - 11 AM & 1 PM - 3 PM
- May 6: Last Names P-Z 9 AM - 11 AM & 1 PM - 3 PM
- May 7: *This day is available to anyone who could not come on their assigned day 9 AM-11 AM & 1 PM-3PM*

Elementary School:

You will come to the front of Colton Elementary School. **You will stay in your car.** A staff member will come up and ask for your student's name and teacher's name. They will then radio for a staff member to bring your student's personal items to you. The staff member will place it in your car for you.

Middle School:

You will come to the front parking lot where students are dropped off at Colton Middle School. You will stay in your car. A staff member will come up and ask for your student's name. They will then radio for a staff member to bring your student's personal items to you. The staff member will place it in your car for you.

High School:

You will come to the front of Colton High School (where buses pull through). You will stay in your car. A staff member will come up and ask for your student's name. They will then radio for a staff member to bring the personal items to your car. The staff member will place it in your car for you.
