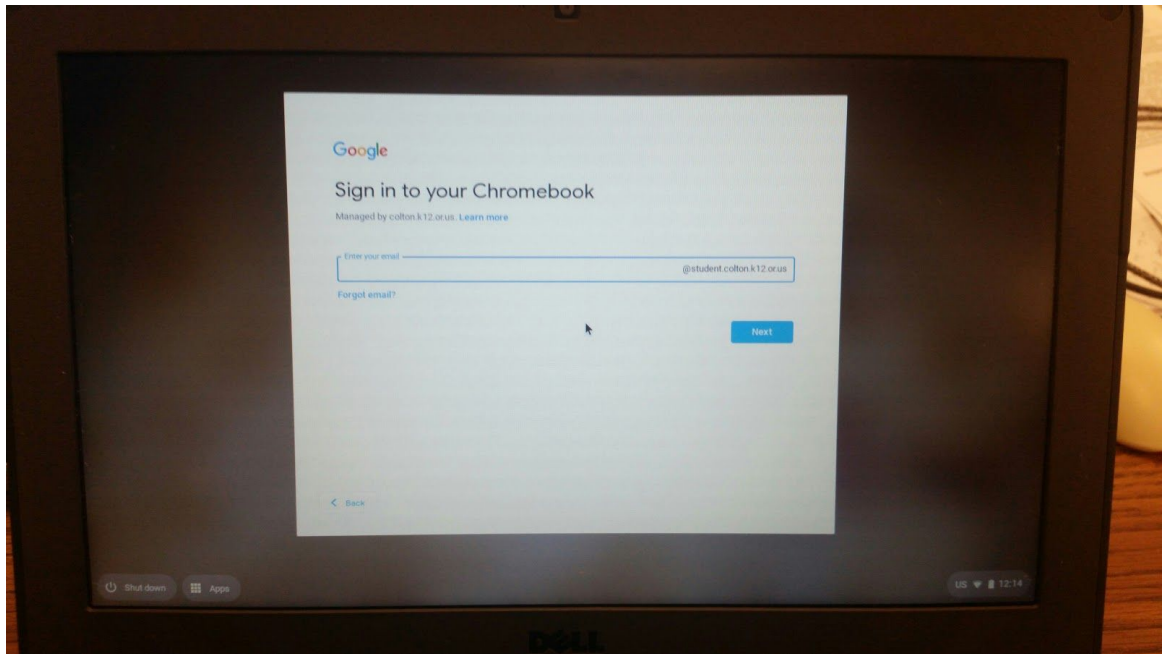
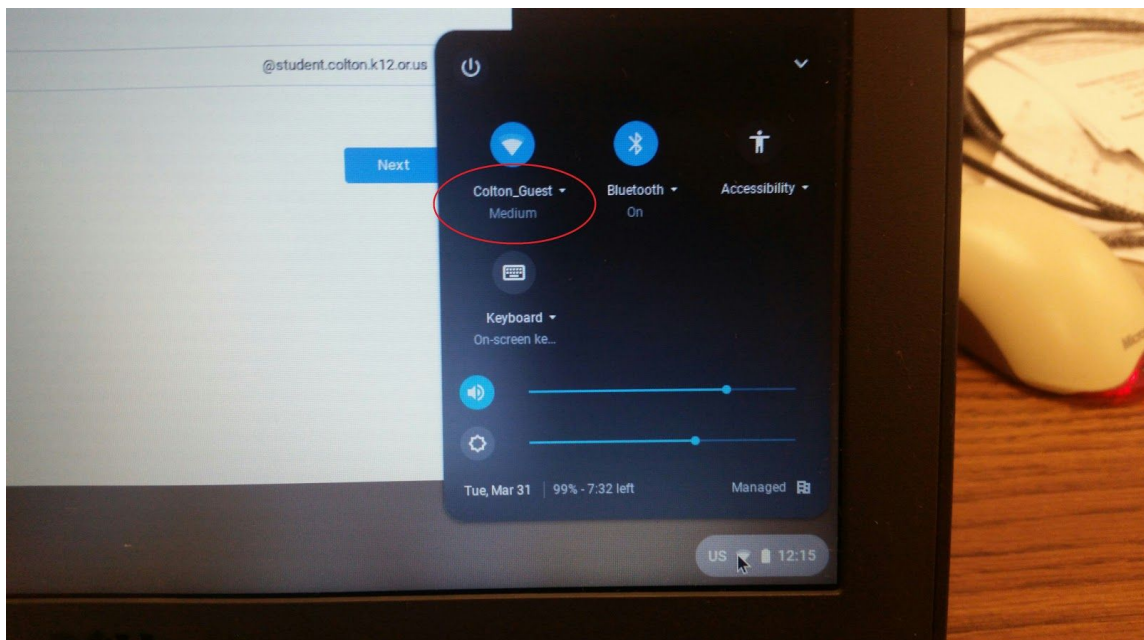


Connecting a Colton Chromebook to Home Wifi 3/31/2020

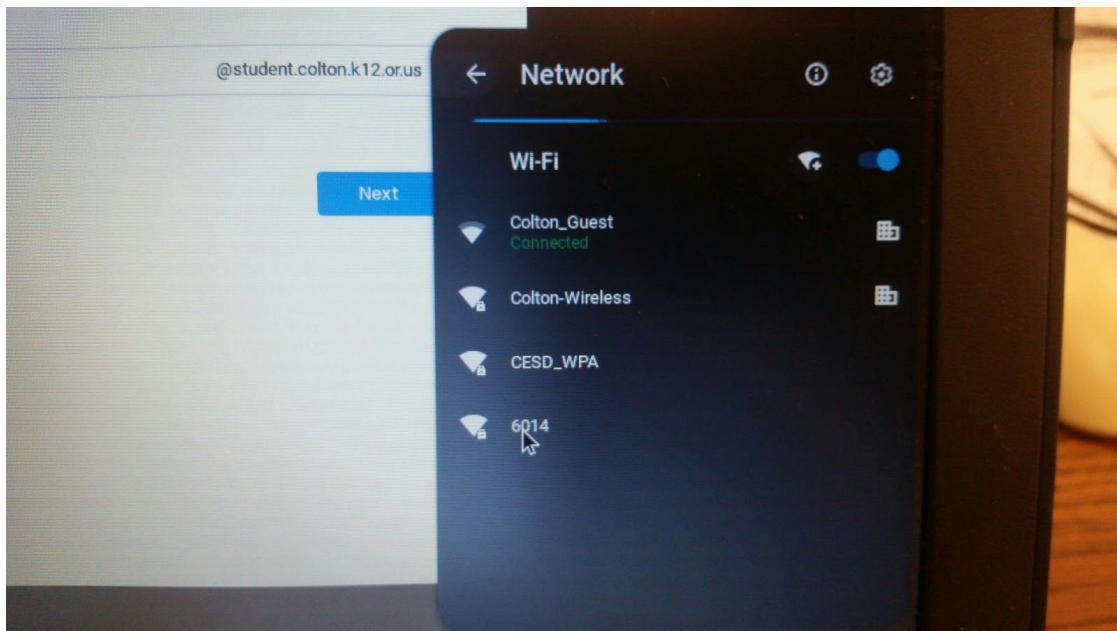
1. The chromebook should look like this at the login screen after taking it out of the bag and turning it on:



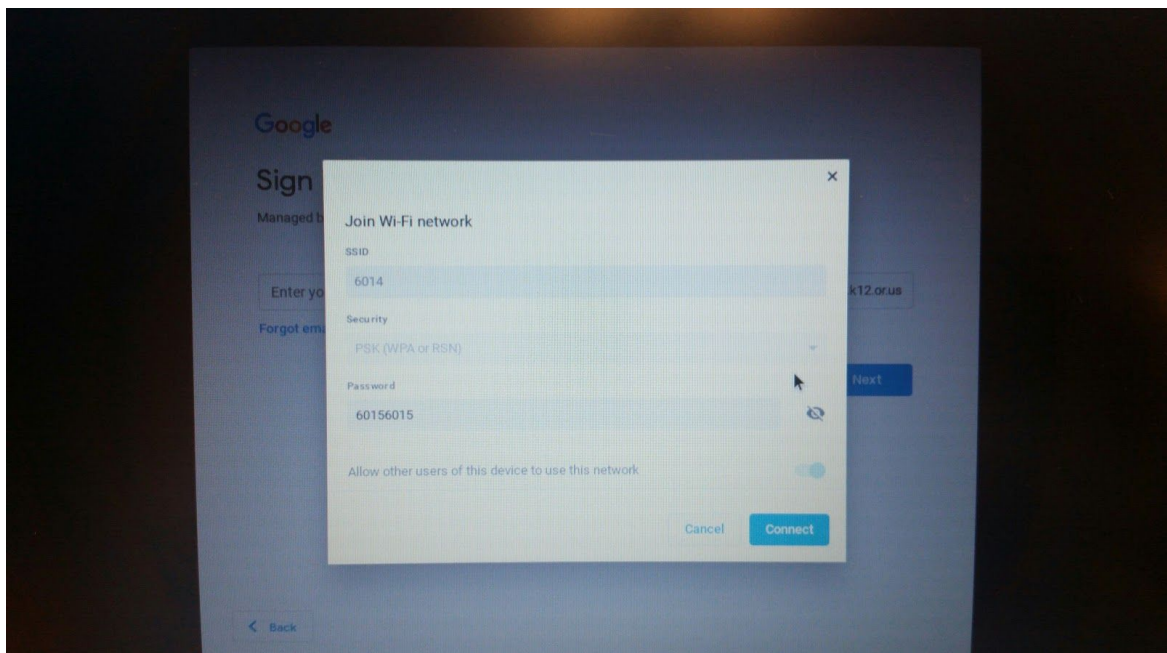
2. Click on the clock icon on the bottom right hand side of the screen to access the settings, and left click on the text beneath the wireless icon (says Colton_Guest in this example):



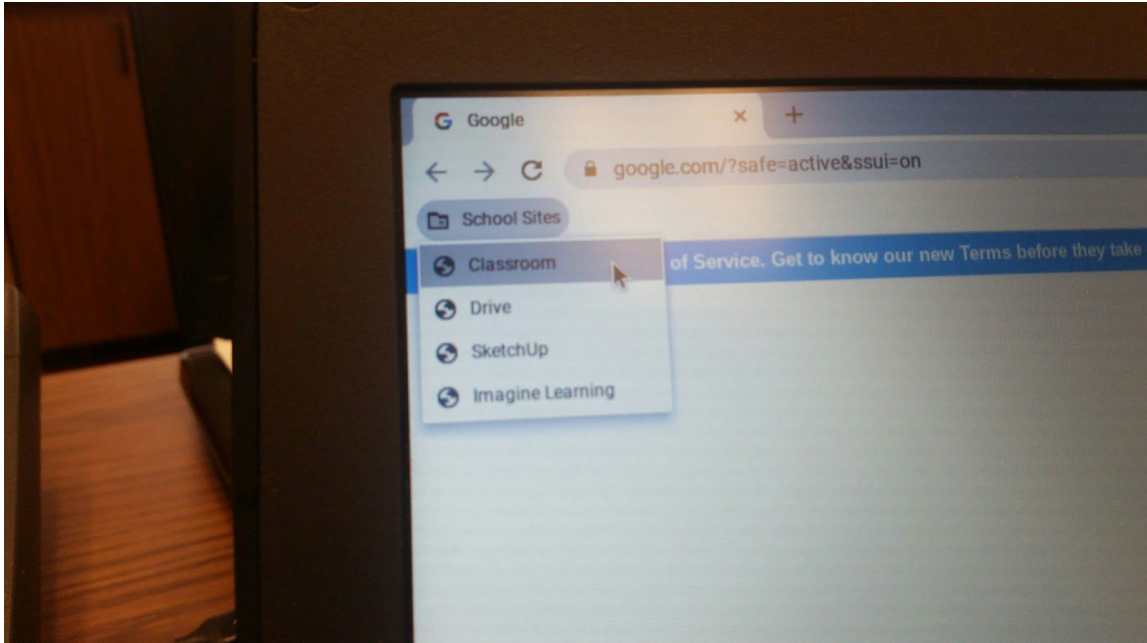
3. Locate and select your Wireless Network/Wifi name. In this example it is the “6014” network.



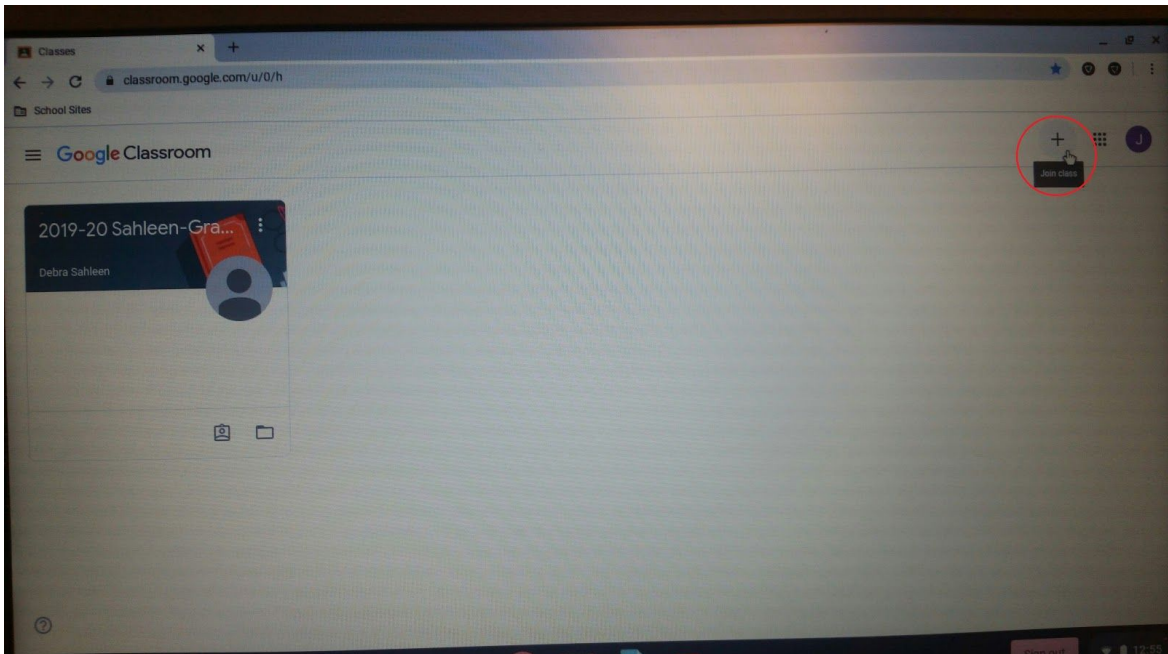
4. The chromebook should prompt you for a password. This password will either be in the documentation with your router, on the side of your router, or stored on other devices:



- When connected, it will return to the sign in screen. Sign in with your email and password, and it will take you to the Google homepage (there is also a Google Chrome icon on the bottom toolbar). There is a shortcut to Google Classroom in the School Sites bookmarks folder:



- The Google Classroom page (classroom.google.com) will launch with enrolled classes. If you have a teacher code to join a class, this can be added with the “+” symbol on the top right:



To use a chromebook with multiple students, sign out using the red “Sign Out” button to return to the login screen. There’s an Add Person button at the bottom left to add another user to the chromebook. The chromebook will remember the last few users that have logged in:
